

NHL STENDEN SCHOLARSHIP MASTER OF ARTS PROGRAMME

What is it about?

The *NHL Stenden Scholarship Master of Arts* aims to attract motivated and talented bachelor students from NHL Stenden to apply for the MA programme offered by NHL Stenden: International Leisure, Tourism and Events Management (ILTEM), and International Hospitality and Service Management (IHSM). Each awarded scholarship represents a partial tuition waiver of six thousand (€ 6.000,-) euros.

Criteria

- MISHM: Applications are open to all nationalities, both from within and outside EEA/EU.
- MILTEM: Applications are open to all nationalities, outside the EEA/EU (applicants with an EEA/EU passport are eligible for the funded fee of € 2.143,-).
- Applications are open to current NHL Stenden bachelor students enrolled in the third and fourth year of study, as offered at any NHL Stenden site. Awarding of the scholarships will be done in the academic year prior to the start of the related academic year.
- In addition, there are also a number of scholarships available for alumni of the above mentioned programmes (see third line).
- In special cases, to be decided by the scholarship programme board, applicants can be exempted of the condition of being a NHL-Stenden student or alumni.
- A scholarship is only be awarded for the above mentioned Master of Arts programme offered by NHL Stenden.
- The Scholarship Programme Board, being the programme leaders of said master single degree programmes, will evaluate and nominate candidates. Academic performance and motivation will be key determinants of acceptance. Nominations are binding.
- The awarded scholarship will act as partial tuition fee waiver, i.e. deducted from the nominal fee for the Master of Arts ILTEM or Master of Arts IHSM.
- If recipients of the scholarship quit their bachelor study before 1 September of the relevant academic year without bachelor certificate, the scholarship will be retracted. It can then be awarded to the next suitable candidate.
- Recipients of the scholarship, quitting their master studies during the relevant academic year, will have their tuition (partially) reimbursed. The scholarship award will be settled accordingly, i.e. (partially) deducted from the reimbursement.
- Students receiving the scholarship are expected to assist in internationalization developments and marketing of the institution (i.e. recruitment, specific research) or act as buddy for new students.

Application and acceptance procedure

- Applicants for the scholarship are required to complete and submit the following:
 - Application form.
 - Motivation letter (max. 1 A4), explaining why the candidate should be considered.
 - Overview of grades and ECTS credits of the third study year. The weighted mean / Grade Point Average should have a minimum of 6.5.
 - Recent resume/CV.
- Applications are only eligible if sent in via email to the Masters Office, masters@nhlstenden.com. The Masters Office will acknowledge if the application meets the formal criteria.
- Applications can be sent in before 01 April 2020.
- The follow up for selected candidates will be an invitation for an intake interview within ten working days after receiving the complete application. NHL Stenden will send an offer letter to successful applicants within ten working days of the completed interview.
- Unqualified candidates will be informed by email, within ten working days after receiving the complete application.
